

## Merit-based scholarships for academic year 2022/23

On Friday, October 6th, 2023, the Kollegium at FHWN released an announcement concerning the meritbased scholarships for the academic year 2022/23. The original announcement is available on our <u>Website</u>.

## **Requirements for eligibility:**

- In summer semester 2023 applicants need to fulfil one of the following criteria. Be inscribed in:
  - 2nd semester of any master programme,
  - 4th semester of any bachelor programme, or
  - 5th semester of the study programme "Allgemeine Gesundheits- und Krankenpflege"(in case the programme began in a summer semester)
- All and any courses up to and including the summer semester 2023 have to have been successfully completed on the first exam entry. This needs to be accomplished by **October 31st**, **2023**.
- Applicants need an overall grade point average of 2,0 or lower
- Applicants have not had to repeat any study year
- No non-assessment of a course ~ "due to non-compliance with an attendance policy"
- No non-assessment of a course ~ "due to cheating or plagiarism"

To file an application, you need to send an email to <u>leistungsstipendium@fhwn.ac.at</u> until **October 31st, 2023.** ~ "The subject line must only contain the ten-digit Personal ID (Personenkennzeichen) or the eight-digit Student ID (Matrikelnummer) as well as the surname and the first name of the applicant, all in this order. In the text of the email, the bank details (IBAN and BIC) are to be mentioned in case of a granting of the scholarship."
